

# Wednesday's sweater

Size S/M



*Pattern by Le Crochet d'Argent - 2022*

**You need:**

4 balls of yarn, 2 white and 2 black

Knitting needles 4 and 4.5

**Technique:**

This involves knitting squares by changing colors using the jacquard technique.

Each square is 21 stitches in 32 rows.

You have to change the order of the colors at rows 46, 78 and 110 for the back and the front.

**BACK**

Cast on 84 stitches on needle 4 with black yarn.

Knit 14 rows in 2/2 ribbing.

Change to needles 4,5 and start the jacquard by knitting :

21 black stitches, 21 white stitches, 21 black stitches, 21 white stitches

Knit 32 rows, then change the order of the colors by knitting :

21 white stitches, 21 black stitches, 21 white stitches, 21 black stitches

At 78 rows of total height, change the color order again by knitting:

black, white, black, white

**AT THE SAME TIME:**

Fold over on each side:

1x3m, 1x2m and 3x1m

There are 68 stitches left

At 110 rows of total height, change again the order of the white and black squares

At 126 rows of total height, fold over the 26 center stitches: 21 stitches remain on each side.

Continue each side separately by folding over

neck side: 1x3m

shoulder side: 3x6m

**FRONT**

Stitch 84 stitches on needle 4 with the black yarn.

Knit 14 rows in 2/2 rib

Change to needles 4,5 and start the jacquard by knitting :

21 black stitches, 21 white stitches, 21 black stitches, 21 white stitches

Knit 32 rows, then change the color of the squares by knitting :

21 white stitches, 21 black stitches, 21 white stitches, 21 black stitches

At 78 rows of total height, change the color order again by knitting:

black, white, black, white

**AT THE SAME TIME:**

Fold over on each side:

1x3m, 1x2m and 3x1m  
AND  
Fold over 1m center

Continue each side separately by folding over for the neckline on each side:  
8x1m every 2 rows  
8x1m every 4 rows

ATTENTION: remember to change the order of the colors every 32 rows of height

Then fold over the shoulders 3x6m

**ASSEMBLY:**

Sew seams the shoulder and side.

**SLEEVES:**

Pick up 108 stitches around armhole and knit 12 rows of 2/2 ribbing.  
Fold over loosely on the 13th row.  
The right sleeve border is knitted in black, the other in white.

**NECK:**

Pick up 78 stitches in white from the tip to the back middle of the neckline, then 78 stitches in black.  
You have a total of 156 stitches with one white and one black side.

Knit in 2/2 ribbing, with a central jacquard in the middle of the row.

Fold over 1 stitch at the beginning and end of each row, knitting together the first 2 stitches at the beginning of the row and the last 2 stitches at the end.

This will allow you to form the center line to make a beautiful V.

Sew the center V with the invisible sew to make a nice center demarcation.

Tuck in your sweater threads and admire your work!
